DATA FROM AMERICAN FORESTS [Tree Equity Score](#), ACCESSED IN 2023:

Census Block Group: A Census block group is a small geographic area used in the United States Census. A block group typically contains between 600 and 3,000 people, but the actual population can vary.

Canopy %: Footprint of existing tree canopy when viewed from above—the bird's eye view of tree crowns (leaves, branches and stems).

Tree Equity Score: A nationwide, block group-level score ranging from 0-100 that highlights inequitable access to trees. The lower the score, the greater priority for tree planting.

% People of color: Percentage of people who are Black or African American, American Indian or Alaska Native, Asian, Native Hawaiian, or Other Pacific Islander, and includes all people classified as Hispanic by the Census Bureau.

% Children and seniors: Percent of population who are seniors (age 65+) and children (0-17).

% People in poverty: Percentage of people living below 200% of the federally-designated poverty line.

Heat Disparity: Surface temperature is a good estimate of where excess heat is generated in urban areas. To measure urban heat severity, a dataset of the highest extremities of 2022 summer surface heat was generated at 30m resolution for all U.S. urban areas. Heat disparity compares the average block group heat extremity with the urban area average to measure variance in heat severity across an urban area. Positive values indicate hotter than average block groups, and negative values indicate cooler than average block groups. If not enough data were available, the block group was set to the urban area average, resulting in a value of zero.

Health Burden Index: Self-reported prevalence of poor mental health, poor physical health, asthma, and heart disease in an equally weighted index. The index ranges from 0 to 1. A higher index indicates poorer health factors.

HOLC Grade: Neighborhood grades from the federal government's Home Owner's Loan Corporation (HOLC) developed in the 1930s that determined who should receive loans. HOLC grades ranged from "A," the highest grade treated as low risk for mortgage lenders, to "D," the lowest grade, deemed "hazardous."
